**Notes for Item 10**

Unbleached fabric which has the natural color of its constituent fibers.

Bleached fabric which is bleached, dyed white or treated with a white dressing.

Dyed fabric which is dyed a single uniform color other than white, or treated with a colored finish other than white or consisting of a colored yarn of a single uniform color.

Yarns of different colors fabric consisting of yarns of different shades of the same color (other than the natural color of the constituent fibers) and fabric consisting of both bleached or unbleached yarn and colored yarn.

Printed fabric which has been printed in the piece, whether or not made of yarns of different colors.

Discharge Printed fabric which has been dyed a single color other than white, dyed fabric in which the previously dyed colors have been bleached or discharged, or fabric which has been subject to two or more of the following: bleaching, shrinking, filling, napping, decating, weighting, permanent stiffening, embossing or moireing
